

Are you prepared? *Recent Challenges of the Data Protection Law*

Lunch Meeting with specialized lawyers from TMI Associates/Arqis

Recently, important amendments have been implemented in the area of the data protection law, both in Japan (amendments to the Act on the Protection on Personal Information, "APPI", effective since May 2017) and in the EU (General Data Protection Regulation, "GDPR", effective as of May 2018). Both may be relevant for companies located in Japan.

The presentation will outline obligations, risks and sanctions (eg GDPR violations may result in penalties of up to 20 million EUR or 4 % of annual global sales), explain which law applies, and which measures should be implemented.

Takashi Yoneyama (at TMI Associates since 2003) is a Japan-qualified lawyer with a focus on International Commercial Law and International Transactions, Keiko Ishikawa (at Arqis since 2008) is a Japan-qualified lawyer with a focus on Labor Law and Distribution Law, and Britta Sueltz (at Arqis since 2008) is a German lawyer and registered foreign attorney with a focus on International Commercial Law and Labor Law. In addition, for all three, the Data Protection Law in Japan and the EU is a common topic of interest and work focus.
