### **About the Nippon Export Award**

The Nippon Export Award was initiated in 2004 by the Belgian-Luxembourg Chamber of Commerce in Japan, and aims to reward companies for significant achievements in exporting to Japan, importing into Japan, or distributing within Japan, Belgian-Luxembourg products or services.

Selection criteria of the Nippon Export Award include:

- Presence in the Japanese market and the company's significant achievements in its trade with Japan
- Vision in new niche markets and daring innovation
- Perseverance in market share growth, adaptability of products and services to Japanese tastes and standards
- Originality of approach (marketing, distribution, environment protection, design, research, etc.)
- The company's spirit (marketing, merchandising, etc.) and values.

Out of 9 candidates, the Nippon Export Award task force selected 4 finalists. The winner was chosen by an independent jury familiar with the Japanese market.

The Nippon Export Award is held under the High Patronage of the Embassy of Belgium in Japan, the Embassy of Luxembourg in Japan, Flanders Investment & Trade (FIT Tokyo), Wallonia Export-Investment Agency (AWEX Tokyo), hub.brussels Tokyo, Luxembourg Trade and Investment Office (LTIO Tokyo) and the Luxembourg Chamber of Commerce, and has the strong support of the Belgo-Luxembourg Market Council (BLMC).
